## City Of P.G. Summer Ice Hockey League

## P.G. Summer Ice Hockey Code Of Conduct:

By selecting "I agree" you are confirming you have <u>read this document</u> and understand and accept the authority of the Governing body in all aspects of application of league rules, including but not limited to suspensions and fines for violations.

The city of P.G. Summer Ice Hockey League is restricted to players that are at least 16 years of age. There is a zero tolerance for alcohol inside any arena. Any participant that is found to have alcohol or is identified as having had alcohol inside any arena will be suspended for the balance of the summer season.

- There is zero tolerance for any type of racial intolerance, Racial Slurs, Homophobic intolerance, or slurs.
- It is understood that this is a mixed gender league, and each team will decide how they share the dressing rooms. If requested, we will try to have a single third dressing room to be shared by either gender (all male or all female) from both teams.
- Appropriate behavior around language, gestures and personal conduct must be maintained in a mixed gender environment.
- Rules for summer hockey are the same as the CAHA rulebook unless otherwise amended in the P.G. Rec. Hockey Handbook that is located on the Westwood Pub PG Rec Hockey League home page of our web site at www.rec-hms.com These rules here may be in addition to, or an amendment to the official CAHA hockey rulebook and the PGRHL handbook. The general philosophy is for the games to be called similar to recreational ice hockey taking into consideration that summer ice hockey is being played for fun and is intended to be noncompetitive.
- If a player is suspended for any incident in The City Of P.G. Summer Hockey League unserved games would carry over to P.G. Rec. and or Gentlemen's Leagues.
- Every player that plays must agree to the waiver. This is to be done at point of registration by reviewing city of P.G. summer ice hockey waiver form and selecting "I AGREE" at point of registration. Underage players will follow instructions for completing and returning the underage parental waiver to the timekeeper before the start of your first game.
- Every Participant must be registered online. The self-registration instructions are on the homepage. Please review the information supplied to team reps regarding registration requirements.
- Any team that allows a player to play without first registering online, will default the game, and receive a minimum \$200.00 team fine. The player will be suspended 2 games.
- The abuse of officials will not be permitted in our league. There will be zero tolerance for abuse of any kind directed at our officials. Any player that does so can expect very severe suspensions, or removal from the league.
- Any player that receives (2) 10-minute misconduct's during the season will be suspended 1 game, and 1 game for each 10-minute misconduct received in any game after that.
- Any player that receives a game misconduct during the season will be suspended a minimum of 1 game, and a minimum of 2 games for each game misconduct received in any game after that.

- Any player that receives (3) aggressive penalties in a game will be ejected.
- We are using the same aggressive points system that is used by the P.G. Rec. Hockey League. Any player that receives (1) aggressive penalty per game is given .2 aggressive points on their permanent record. Any player that receives (2) aggressive penalties per game is given 1 aggressive point on their permanent record. Any player that receives (3) aggressive penalties per game, is ejected from the game, and given 2 aggressive points on their permanent record. Once a player reaches 3 aggressive points on their record, they will be suspended for 1 game. A two-game suspension will be given for each aggressive point there after. (For more information on the aggressive points team reps. can contact me.)
- Any player that receives a non-fighting major is automatically suspended pending a review of the incident and is ineligible to play again until the length of suspension is determined following a review.
- Any player that receives a fighting major is automatically suspended automatically suspended pending a review of the incident and is ineligible to play again until the length of suspension is determined following a review. The minimum suspension for fighting is 3 games.
- Any player that receives a 2<sup>nd</sup> fighting major is automatically suspended for the rest of the season. If less than 5 games remain in the summer season unserved games would carry over to P.G. Rec. and or Gentlemen's Leagues.
- Any player that receives a gross misconduct or a match penalty will be suspended indefinitely.
  pending a review of the incident and is ineligible to play again until the length of suspension is determined following a review.
- Any team that allows a suspended player to play will receive a minimum \$100.00 team fine.
- Every player must wear a CSA approved helmet, and all other protective gear must be CSA approved.
  Goalies must wear a protective neck guard. (Either the neck protector that is worn, or the type that hangs down from the mask. Contact with the goaltenders is strictly prohibited and will result in penalties to the offending players.
- Anyone under the age of 18 must wear a full face protective shield.
- A minimum of 6 eligible players (1 goal tender and 5 skaters) must be ready to start the game at the conclusion of the 10-minute warm up. If a team cannot meet this requirement they will receive a 2 minute minor penalty and be given 10 minutes grace to find a goal tender or additional player. At the conclusion of the 10 minutes of grace if the team is unable to start with the minimum required players the game is recorded as a 1-0 default and the team may be fined up to \$100.00 to be paid to the opposition team.
- Each game will be timed as follows. A 10-minute warm up. A 25-minute first period, with the last 30 seconds stop time. (Teams change ends.) A 25-minute second period, with the last 30 seconds stop time. A 25-minute third period, with the last 5-minutes stop time.
