Roster requirement

Non-Compliance with Roster rules regarding spare players.

Review the information here there are no more warnings. Any team that is not following the rules will be fined as described here.

There seems to be some confusion about the spare player requirement extending to Goaltenders.

That is certainly not the case. Goalies must be registered and listed.

Here are the rules simplified.

Roster requirement:

Teams are required to provide an up-to-date team roster with **correct team jersey numbers** and players not in attendance crossed off to the timekeeper at the beginning of every game when they go onto the ice.

If you fail to hand in a correct team roster the following fines will be incurred. A correct team roster is a roster printed from the league database for your team! Nothing else is accepted.

- Any Team not in compliance will be fined \$20 then it will go up in \$5 increments until it gets to \$50 and that will remain the fee.

Correct listing of a Spare player (Anyone Not On Your Teams Roster):

If a team uses a spare player, they are required to list the **Players full name** spelled correctly with the **name of the team and league they are registered with** in either Rec League or Gentlemen's. If you are abbreviating the team's name, it must be easy to define without a doubt what team they play on.

Failure to follow this requirement will result in a \$100 team fine, no exceptions. Failure to provide a team roster and using spares will be an automatic \$100 and \$20(+) fine.

Here are some examples of how spares are to be listed at the bottom of your team roster:

Wayne Gretzky (GM) Hawks

Bobby Orr (Rec) All Pro Leafs

Thatcher Demko (Rec) TBA (goaltender)

Hayley Wickenheiser (GM) To Be Announced

Bo Horvat (Rec) Canada west

- **Timekeepers will not ask for the roster you are expected to hand it to them when you go onto the ice.**
