## City Of P.G. Summer Ice Hockey League

## P.G. Summer Ice Hockey Code Of Conduct:

By selecting "I agree" you are confirming you have <u>read this document</u> and understand and accept the authority of the Governing body in all aspects of application of league rules, including but not limited to suspensions and fines for violations.

The city of P.G. Summer Ice Hockey League is restricted to players that are at least 16 years of age. <u>A parental</u> waiver is required for underage players under the age of 19.

The possession or consumption of alcohol within any arena is not allowed. Any participant found with alcohol or identified as having consumed alcohol inside any arena will be suspended for the remainder of the summer season. The use of any tobacco products, including vapes or "chew," is also prohibited inside any city arena.

- There is zero tolerance for any type of racial intolerance, Racial Slurs, Homophobic intolerance, or slurs.
- This is a mixed gender league, and each team will manage their dressing rooms. If requested in advance, a third dressing room will be provided for either gender from both teams.
- Appropriate behavior around language, gestures and personal conduct must be maintained in a mixed gender environment.
- Summer hockey follows CAHA rules unless amended in the P.G. Rec. Hockey Handbook, available on the Westwood Pub PG Rec Hockey League website at www.rec-hms.com. These rules may add to or amend the CAHA and PGRHL handbooks. Games should reflect recreational ice hockey and emphasize **fun** over competition.
- If a player is suspended for any incident in The City Of P.G. Summer Hockey League unserved games would carry over to P.G. Rec. and or Gentlemen's Leagues.
- All players must agree to the waiver at registration by reviewing the City of P.G. summer ice hockey waiver form and selecting "I AGREE". Underage players must complete and return the parental waiver to the timekeeper before their first game.
- Every Participant must be registered online. The self-registration instructions are on the homepage. Please review the information supplied to team reps regarding registration requirements.
- Any team that permits a player to participate without first registering online will forfeit the game and be subject to a minimum \$200.00 team fine. The player will be suspended for 2 games.
- Abuse of officials is prohibited in our league. Players who engage in such conduct will face severe suspensions or removal from the league.
- A player who gets two 10-minute misconducts for abusing an official will be suspended for 2 games. A third offense results in suspension for the rest of the season.
- Any player that receives a game misconduct during the season will be suspended a minimum of 2 games, A second offense results in suspension for the rest of the season.
- We are using the same aggressive points system that is used by the P.G. Rec. Hockey League.
  Accumulation of aggressive points is explained on Page 4 of the "Rules and Discipline" portion of the
  handbook located on the Westwood Pub PG Rec Hockey League portal home page. (For more
  information on the aggressive points team reps. can contact me.)
- Any player that receives (3) aggressive penalties in a game will be ejected and suspended for 1 game.

- Any player that accumulates 3 aggressive points is suspended for 2 games. If a player accumulates 4 aggressive points they are suspended for the balance of the season.
- Any player that receives a non-fighting major is automatically suspended pending a review of the incident and is ineligible to play again until the length of suspension is determined following a review.
- Any player that receives a fighting major is automatically suspended automatically suspended pending a review of the incident and is ineligible to play again until the length of suspension is determined following a review. The minimum suspension for fighting is 4 games.
- Any player receiving a second fighting major is suspended for the rest of the season. If fewer than 5 games remain, the suspension carries over to P.G. Rec or Gentlemen's Leagues.
- Any player who receives a gross misconduct or match penalty will be suspended indefinitely, pending a review of the incident. The player is ineligible to play until the suspension length is determined after the review.
- Any team that allows a suspended player to play will receive a minimum \$200.00 team fine.
- All players must wear CSA-approved helmets and gear. <u>Goalies must wear neck guards</u>. Any contact with goalies is prohibited and will result in penalties.
- Anyone under the age of 18 must wear a full-face protective shield.
- A minimum of 6 eligible players (1 goal tender and 5 skaters) must be ready to start the game at the conclusion of the 6-minute warm up. If a team cannot meet this requirement, they will receive a 2 minute minor penalty and be given 10 minutes grace to find a goal tender or additional player. At the conclusion of the 10 minutes of grace if the team is unable to start with the minimum required players the game is recorded as a 1-0 default and the team may be fined up to \$100.00 to be paid to the opposition team.
- Each game will be timed as follows. A 6-minute warm up. A 20-minute first and second period, with the last 30 seconds stop time. (Teams change ends.) A 20-minute third period, with the last 5-minutes stop time.
